Gotirth Vidyapeeth - Vedic Education

Gotirth Vidyapeeth, following on the traditions of Guru-Shishya parampara focuses on the physical, mental, intellectual and spiritual development of a child. Gopalan, Go-Krishi, Ayurveda, Dharmanukul Arthavyastha (closest possible English translation being 'Principle-centered Economics') and Acharya Nirman are the core subjects of the Vidyapeeth. The students here also learn various skills such as music, martial arts, preparation of Ayurvedic medicines, reciting Shlokas, performing Vedic Yagnas, Vedic Mathematics, Yoga, Malkham (rope & pole gymnastics), languages (Sanskrit, Gujarati, Hindi and English), etc.

Keeping in mind the purity and sanctity of educational environment & class schedules, the Gurukul campus is open for visitors by prior appointment only, between 5 to 6 pm in the evenings on all days except Sunday.



Bansi Gir Gaushala - Vedic Gopalan

- Fully Organic & Vedic Gaushala –Bansi Gir Gaushala is a leading Centre of Excellence in Bharat for Vedic 'Gopalan' ('Cow' rearing & breeding). We have 700+ Gomata's spread across 18 Gotra's (closest English word being lineage) of Gir breed who are reared in accordance of ancient Vedic practices.
- The Gaushala is working to revive Bharat's ancient "Gau Sanskriti', and firmly believes that many of the problems facing humanity, particularly in the field of Gopalan, Agriculture, Health & Education can only be solved with Gaumata at the Centre of all Life Activities. Some salient features of this Gaushala are detailed below.
- Gomata's ('Cow' as Divine Mother) at The Gaushala are generally far healthier than average 'cattle' reared in the dairy industry. We have Gomata's who give 20 liters of milk at the age of 22 years after giving birth to 16 calves.
- Here Gomata's are not tied, they graze unrestricted in a field nurtured by natural manure, and on dry feed which is non-GMO and pure & ethically grown as far as possible. The dry feed is also enriched with Ayurvedic herbs.
- Entire Gomata family is looked after The Gaushala never 'gets rid of' older non-lactating Gomata's or male calves.
- Only natural 'Gopalan' practices are followed, we don't use artificial insemination or hormonal interventions to increase milk 'production'.
- Daily 'devotional music and havans' (sacrificial fire ritual) which modern research proves has beneficial effects on the surroundings with its ability to eliminate pathogenic bacteria.



Dohan - Ahinsak (non-exploitative) & Ethical Gopalan

Bansi Gir Gaushala strictly adheres to the ancient Vedic tradition of 'Dohan', wherein the calf is allowed to feed to its satisfaction from two 'Anchals', while the remaining two are used to obtain milk for other living beings. This results in happier Gaumata's who know that their calf is also fed, as well as healthier Gaumata's.



Gaukrishi - Gau Based Natural Farming

- Fully Organic Gau-Krushi ('Cow' based organic farming) farms

 Our Gaushala is also a leading Centre of Excellence in Bharat for 'Gau Krushi'. Our farm is not meant for large scale commercial farming, but a research and demonstration model for farmers, agricultural scientists and students.
- Our farming practices are at the cutting edge of organic agricultural technology, with our Gaushala having pioneered several farming innovations.

- We work with leading agricultural scientists in the country who also visit us regularly to exchange knowledge and information.
 Farmers from across the country visit us regularly to learn about organic and Gomata based agriculture.
- We firmly believe that modern humanity needs to exploit the valuable synergies that exist between Gopalan and Agriculture. Our efforts are aimed at helping farmers revive this link, so that they may regain the prosperity they enjoyed in ancient Bharat.



Gauveda - Gau Based Ayurveda
